- 8. Summary of the project.

This project will establish management of the Ngamikka National park which is in the process of being established as well as the Luama Katanga Reserve which already exists on paper but has had no personnel since 1984. The focus will be on engaging the local community in planning for the management of the landscape as well establishing the basic infrastructure and capacity to enable this to happen.

We will be constructing two monitoring outposts/stations to provide bases for the monitoring officers. During the construction process there will be a need to ensure the health and safety of workers on the construction site. We will be subcontracting out the work to a local building company but will insist that the measures summarized below are put in place by this company to ensure that the workers health and safety is ensured.

11. Actions to ensure health and safety: Describe actions that will be taken to ensure the health and safety of workers as well as the site. Include a description of waste management and/or disposal.

The following measures will need to be put in place:

- a. Hard hats to be worn by all workers and overalls supplied and worn
- b. Tough boots and tough gloves to be supplied and worn by all workers
- c. For station along the lake transportation by large boats (not dugout canoes) and lifejackets supplied to all personnel
- d. Ensuring that each level of the building is completed and cement dried before starting the next level
- e. Medical kit to be kept at site and at least two people trained in first aid
- **12.** <u>Budget:</u> Please provide an estimate of the cost of implementing the health and safety plan, and clarify the source of funds (including if these are CEPF funds)

These funds will come from the \$20,000 construction costs for each station and will be stipulated in the contract. We estimate that the costs will be of the order of \$500-1000 USD
