

COMPOST TOILET REPORT:

Total number: 11 Compost Toilets built in the pilot project and these were completed by year 2012

Cata Agricultural enterprise irrigation scheme: we built successfully two compost toilet. There was no toilet in this area. In the agriculture there are 25 people that are the benefiting under these toilets. They are producing fresh vegetable crops.

Chalet accommodation: this is a guest lodge for the community, 1 toilet was built for the workers.

Before the construction of the compost toilet it was hard for the workers as this place was meant to entertain the visitors, they interrupt the guest by using same ablutions for our guest. In the case accommodation those hygienic toilet played an important role

Primary school: 2 toilets were built and the teachers as we are in the village they are using them. In terms of hygiene those toilet are suitable for communities. Our neighbour communities have copied the model and apply it in their communities.

Community hall: there are many activities happening in this hall. They are more important because they accommodate large amount of people that are using the hall in different activities.

Homestay accommodation: There are 4 hosts that were chosen as they have the ability to accommodate the guest in their houses. One of the reason those toilet are comfortable and hygienic for the international and domestic visitors so we were trying to promote the building of it by individuals.

We thank the Wildlands by funding Cata with those toilets. There were many young people that took part in the construction of those toilets. They benefit more in the skills development. The others are no longer employed by the Cata CPA programme, decided to employ themselves by building community houses.
